Out of the Box

Make sure the shipping box contains these items:

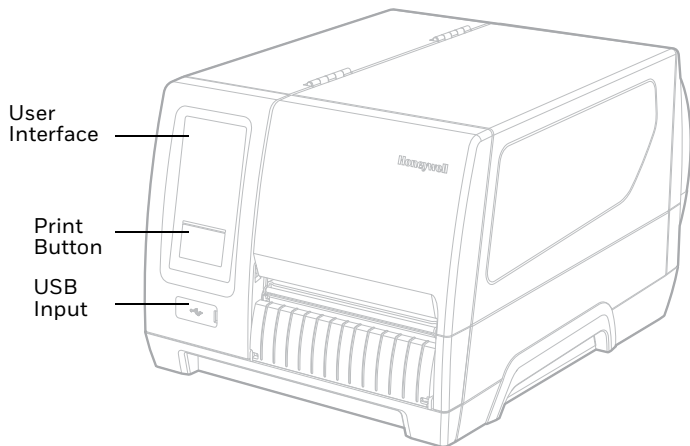
- Printer

Note: *Power cord inclusion is SKU dependent and may need to be ordered separately. Contact your local sales representative for assistance.*

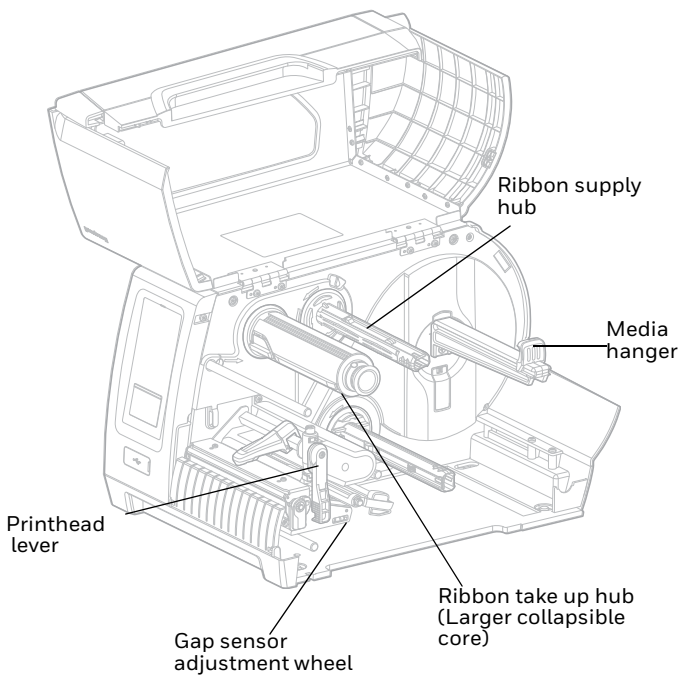
If you have ordered accessories for your printer, verify that they are included in the order. Be sure to keep the original packaging in case you need to return the printer.

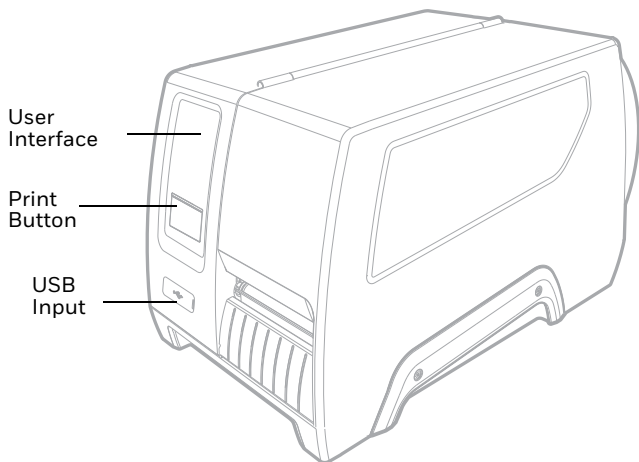

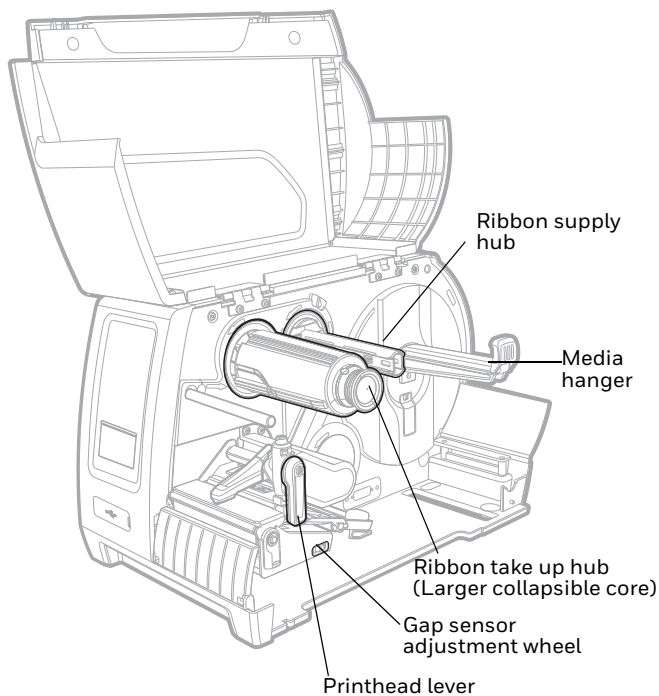
PM65 Internal View



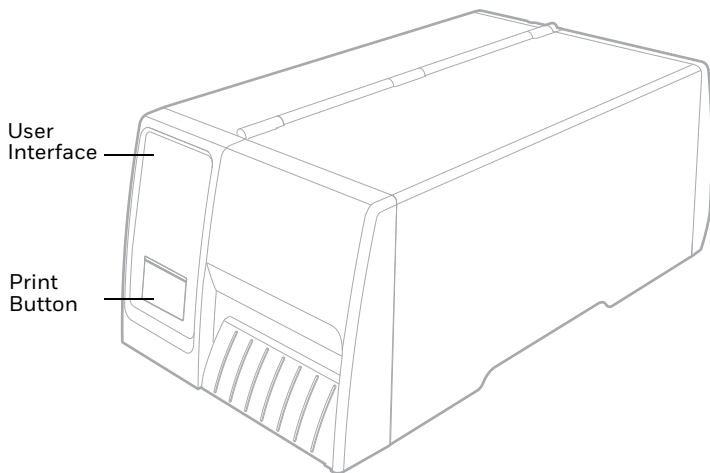

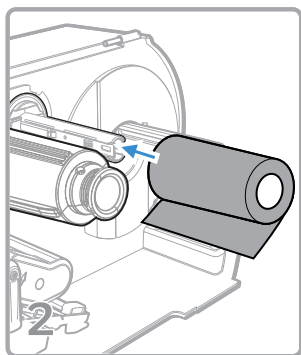
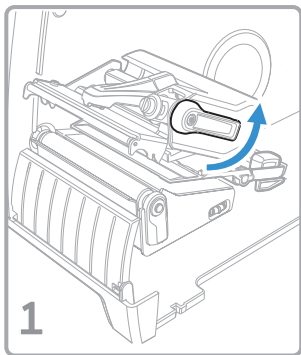
Note: This procedure applies for all three models of the printers. For simplicity, the PM45 printer is depicted in the illustrations.

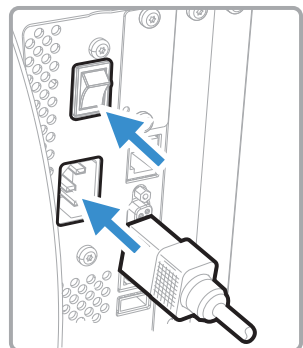
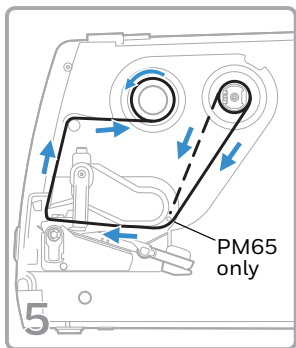
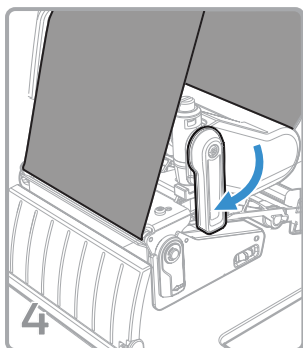
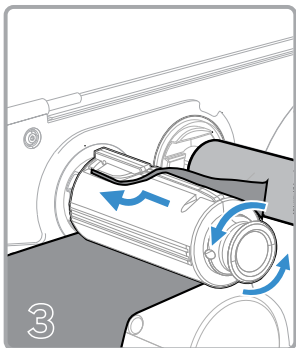

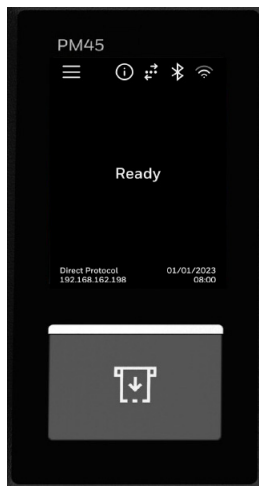




Front Panel and Display

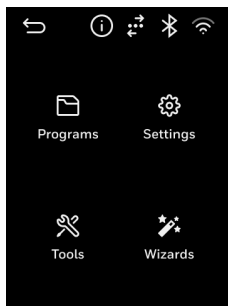

LED Icon Display - Color and Indication

LED Display Status Indicators	Color	Indication
 Wi-fi Signal	White	Wireless Signal.
	Off	Wireless radio disabled or not installed.
 Connectivity	White	Steady connection.
	Off	No data is being sent or received.
 Bluetooth	White	Bluetooth is enabled.
	Off	Bluetooth is disabled or not installed.
 Media	Red	Out of media or there is problem with the media (jammed, not loaded correctly).
	Off	Media is available and loaded correctly.
 Printer Configuration	Red	There is a printer configuration problem.
	Off	There are no configuration problems.

LED Display Status Indicators	Color	Indication
 Ribbon	Red	Out of ribbon or there is problem with the ribbon (not feeding or loaded incorrectly).
	Off	Ribbon is good or the printer is not configured to use ribbon.
 Printhead Hot	Red	The printhead is too hot.
	Off	The printhead temperature is normal and ready for printing.
 Printhead Lifted	Red	Printhead is lifted.
	Off	Printhead is lowered.
 General Error	Red	There is a printer problem not associated with any of the other icons.
	Off	There are no general errors.
 Pause	White	The printer is paused.
	Off	The printer is not paused.
 Maintenance	Amber	Maintenance is required and a lifetime odometer setting is reached.
	Off	No maintenance is required.

Touchscreen Printer - Ready Screen and Main Menu



Touchscreen Menu Icons

Touchscreen Menu Icons	Press to:
 Main Menu	View the main menu of the printer.
 Printing	View specific printer information.
 Wi-Fi Connectivity	View Wi-Fi connection information.
 Bluetooth	View Bluetooth/Bluetooth LE information for the printer.

Touchscreen Menu Icons	Press to:
 Communications	View communications information for the printer.
 Back	Navigate back through the printer menus.
 Home	Return to the Ready screen.

Print Button

Use the **Print** button  to feed media, pause print jobs, calibrate, test feed, and print.

Printer State	Print Button Action
Startup	Press the Print button during startup to enter Calibration mode or to restore defaults if the printhead is lifted.
Ready	Press the Print button to advance the media. Press and hold the Print button for smart calibration.
Printing	Press the Print button to stop or pause printing. The printer stops after completing the current label.

Printer State	Print Button Action
Paused	Press the Print button to resume printing.
Error	Press the Print button to advance the media.

Print a Test Label on LED Display Model

Once the printer is turned on, the printer goes through its startup sequence and all of the LEDs light up. When the last two LEDs are lit (Printhead Hot and Maintenance):

1. Press and hold the **Print** button until the test label starts to print.
2. Release the **Print** button.

Your test label prints.

Print a Test Label on Touchscreen Display Model

Once the printer is turned on, it runs a startup wizard to let you enter basic setup information.

1. Enter all the information on the wizard screens. Click **No** when prompted to run other wizards.
2. From the Ready screen, tap the **Main Menu** .
3. From the Main Menu, tap **Tools > Test Labels**.
4. Select the test label you want to print and tap it.

Your test label prints.
